There are many questions we have about dying, death, funerals and the after-life... but often there is no right time or safe space to talk about these things.


A series of events are being arranged to allow us to find out more about what happens when someone dies, why it is important to write a Will, and a chance to ask and explore issues surrounding our own and others death.
