Did you know... the first printed Bible was the Gutenberg Bible in 1455. Every Bible before this time would have been hand copied and this work was often done in monasteries. Bibles were so expensive that few people had their own copy.

Only 48 copies of the Gutenberg Bible still exist and two of these are in the British Library. If you near Kings Cross with a bit of spare time why not pop into the Treasure Room at the British Library and have a look. It is free entry.

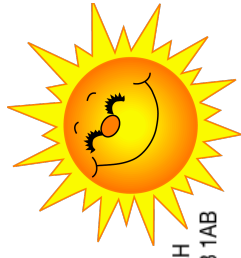
